It is not a competition but a challenge to each student to read, to read more and to read more widely".

The Challenge is divided into three categories: Kinder - Year 2 (30 books), Years 3 - 4 (20 books) and Years 5 - 6 (20 books). Students have until August 30 to complete their reading.
