University of Newcastle – Pre-Service Education Student Placements

Mayfield West Demonstration School, as a partner school of the University of Newcastle, is currently hosting 10 first year Master of Teaching Students each Friday. This work integrated learning program supports our future teachers in gaining an understanding of what the work of a teacher involves. These students are involved in lesson observations and micro teaching opportunities. They had their inductions recently and are thoroughly enjoying working with the wonderful students at our school.



We also have approximately 100 second-year undergraduate pre-service education students from the University of Newcastle observing teachers at our school during literacy sessions this week. The focus is on enhancing the students' knowledge and experiences of teaching and learning in literacy, with a focus on reading. The students do professional learning with Mrs Foley (AP Curriculum and Instruction), Mr Bradley and Mr Morrison to develop an understanding of core aspects of literacy instruction, including the development of phonological and phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary knowledge and

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comprehension. This practical experience will enable the students from the university to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and authentic classroom practices.

Opportunity classes are special classes for students who have high academic potential. They are offered for students who are in Year 4 this year and will be going into Year 5 for 2025. To be considered for a place in an opportunity class, parents/carers will need to apply, and students will need to sit a test. Students who are

Opportunity Class Pilot Testing 2025

Selective high school and opportunity class placement tests will become computer-based tests in 2025. The Department of Education is calling for students to participate in a pilot of the computer-based placement tests to help them prepare for this change.

It's free and open to students in Year 3 to sit the pilot opportunity class placement test and students in Year 5 to sit the pilot selective high school placement test. The pilot will be held on Saturday 22 June 2024 at test centres in Sydney, Newcastle and Bathurst. Parents of eligible students are invited to submit an expression of interest for their child to participate in the pilot at the University of Newcastle, Callaghan.

Expressions of interest are open between 26 March – 12 April 2024.

This is a good opportunity for students to take a practice test ahead of the computer-based placement tests in 2025. Computers will be provided at the pilot test venues for all participating students.


