CBCA Book of the Year Awards

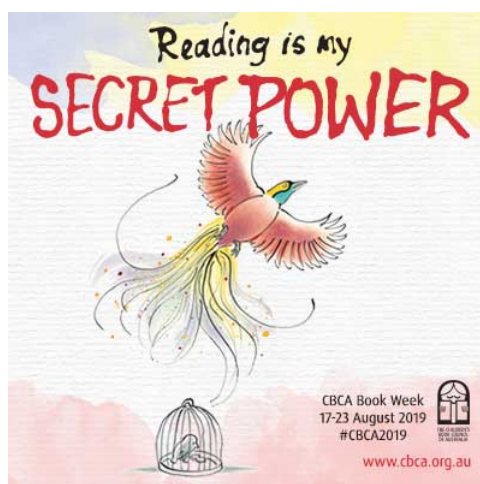
