Congratulations to Finn Merber and Cameron Masters who were selected to participate in the Hunter AFL Trials to be held on Tuesday 19th March.

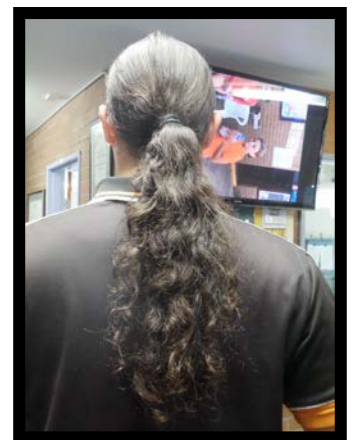
Resource packs

Premier's Reading Challenge 2019

The PRC is now underway! I would encourage all students K - 6 to enter as it provides a great incentive to read some wonderful books. To enter just follow these steps:

1. Go to the website <https://online.det.nsw.edu.au/prc/studentExperience.html#/>

Click on *Log in* and enter your school username (eg. sally.smith) and your school password and click submit. 2. You are required to read 30 books (K - 2) or 20 books (3 - 6) by 30th August from the PRC book list. Five books can be of your own choice, however they should be of similar quality to those on the list. Students can borrow PRC books from the school library and public libraries also have a large selection. 3. Fill in the Online Reading Record as you go along. Please see Mrs Troup in the library if you need any help accessing or filling in your record.
